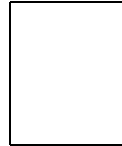

# 1 Feature

The XPE is the component version of the Windows XP operating system and is the operating system which has the discriminative function about an embedded device such as the Write Filter.

The XPE made by Pro-face has the following features.

**IMPORTANT**

- The CF card must be connected to the primary master (Disk 0).
- Back up the data after installing the required application programs. Data cannot be recovered without backup data.

**NOTE**

## ■ Write Filter Function(The function to protect the CF card from writing)

This function protects the CF card from writing.

Be sure the Write Filter is effective to decrease the number of times of writing to CF card. And if the Write Filter function is effective, the operation for shutdown is unnecessary.

## ■ Supporting Multi-language Function (Only for Multi-language XPE)

Multilanguage such as English, Spanish, French, German, Italian,Russian,Chinese, and Taiwanies is supported.

**NOTE**

- Japanese XPE does not have this function.
- For deleting unnecessary languages, refer to [7.4 Delete Language]

## ■ Supporting Combination Use with HDD Function

Combining with HDD can extend the data area and therefore a large-sized application can be used.

**NOTE**

- PS-3650A /PS-3651A and PS-3700A/PS-3701A Series do not have this function.

## ■ Backlight Screen Saver Function

It's the screen saver function that turns ON/OFF the backlight and can extend the backlight's lifetime.

### NOTE

- PS-2000B does not have this function.

## ■ Installed System Monitor

It enables Error Monitor of the system.

For details, refer to IPC Series Reference Manual.

## ■ Supporting Touch Panel Driver (UPDD)

The input operation like a mouse is possible with the touch operation.

### NOTE

- The UPDD is not installed in PS-2000B before shipment. Please install it if needed.

## ■ Installed KeyClick

It displays the keyboard on a screen and enables the key input from the touch panel.

## ■ RAM Disk

Use the RAM Disk to solve the memory leak caused by the Write filter.

RAM Disk will enable to write the data directly into the memory area.

Therefore, the area of the RAM Disk can be used again and again whether the Write filter is enabled or not.

The function and the setting of the Control Panel in the XPE are as below.

BackLight Brightness* <sup>1</sup>	Change Backlight Brightness settings.  "7.1 Backlight Brightness" (Page 1-16)	The backlight can be set to any of 4 levels of brightness. The initial setting is the maximum.

## 4 Write Filter

XPE has the Write Filter (The function to avoid writing into HDD or Flash Memory). When the Write Filter is effective, it prevents writing into CF card.

**IMPORTANT**

- When data is written in the devices (except CF card) that are not protected by the Write Filter, turning off the power may cause damage of the data.

 "8 Notes on turning off the power" (Page 1-25)

- To make each setting, add a driver, or change Registry, be sure to disable the Write Filter setting. If the Write Filter setting is enabled, the setting information to OS and so on will be all canceled when OS re-starts. When changing the setting, be sure to disable the Write Filter setting.
- It's not applied to the CF card for writing data, which is used for PCMCIA.

## 4.1 Write Filter Settings Procedure

When setting the Write Filter, use "EFWSettingTool.exe". This tool has the following function.

- The Write Filter invalid (EWF Disable).
- The Write Filter effective (EWF Enable).
- Change of security ID.

**IMPORTANT**

- You have to log on as administrator in order to set the Write Filter.

**NOTE**

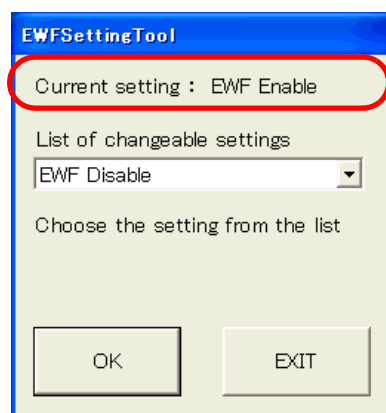
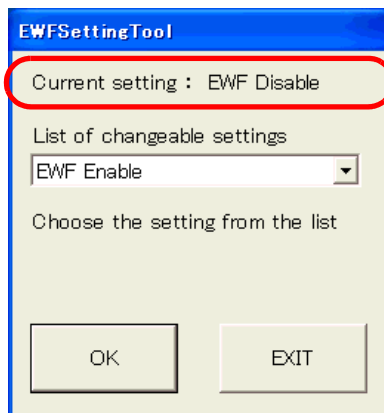
- Be sure the Write Filter is invalid to change the security ID.
- Only when you copy the CF card for starting and install the application program in more than one unit, Changing of security ID becomes effective.
- For the information of the security ID, refer to the "4 Security ID".

☞ "5 Copying the CF card" (Page 1-11)

- (1) Select [Designate file name and run] from the [Start] menu and start the following executable file.

C:\Proface\EWFSettingTool\EWFSettingTool.exe

- (2) Confirm current setting on the display screen.



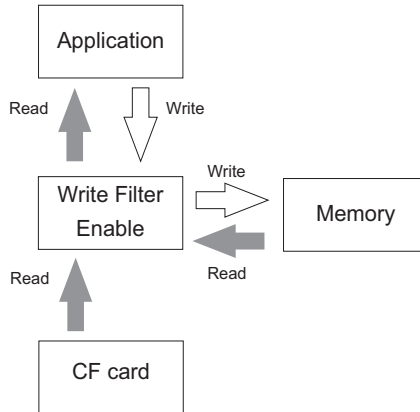
- (3) Choose the setting from the list.
- (4) Click [OK] and end.

\* Restart and the contents of change becomes effective.

## 4.2 Access operation to the CF card of the Write filter

### ■ When the Write Filter is enabled

- Read: Direct access to CF card
- Write: Access to the memory



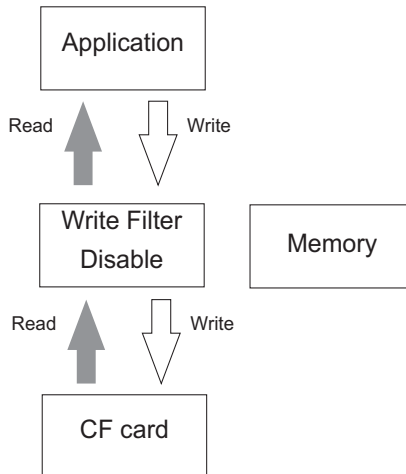
**NOTE**

- When the added or changed data is on the memory, the data on the memory precedes.
- The memory leak will be caused, when accessing to the Write Filter enabled CF card. To solve the memory leak caused by the Write filter, refer to the following below.

☞ "6 RAM Disk" (Page 1-13)

### ■ When the Write Filter is disabled

- Read: Direct access to CF card
- Write: Direct access to CF card



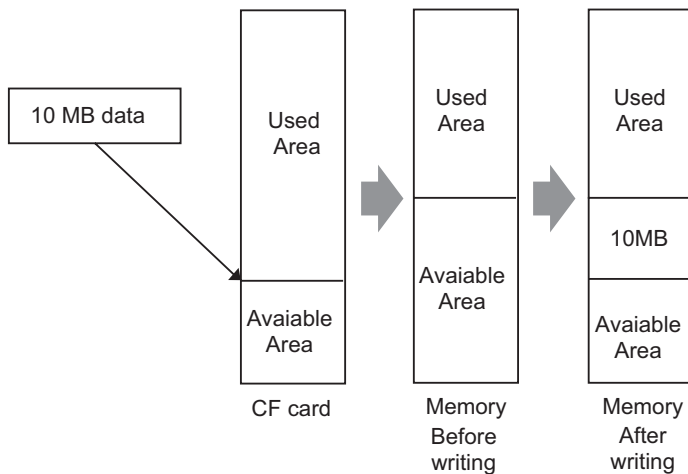
**NOTE**

- Turning OFF the power at the time of writing into CF card leads to data damage. When using this unit, use it with the Write Filter effective. Prevention of writing into the CF card is expected to prevent being damaged or prevent the CF card life cycle (Reference: 0°C - 70°C , Writing/Delete Times: 300,000 times per block) from declining as well.

## ■ Write Filter-related important notes

- If the Write Filter is effective, when writing to the CF card, data is written on the memory. However, even if the written information is deleted in the CF card, the information on the memory cannot be deleted. To delete the information on the memory, it's necessary to restart the system.
- Even if the CF card has a available area, when the memory has no available area, writing data causes the disk's insufficient available area error. And when the memory has a available area and the CF card has no available area, the Writing Error occurs and data cannot be written. When writing data, be sure to check available areas of the CF card and the memory.

Ex.) With the Write Filter effective, when writing 10-MB data,



<Conditions to write 10-MB data>

- The appearing available area in the CF card is 10 MB or more
- The memory's available area: 10MB + memory's available area necessary for OS to operate properly.

<State after 10-MB data is written>

- The appearing available area in the CF card decreases by 10 MB.
- The available area in the memory decreases by 10 MB.

<State after 10-MB data is deleted>

- The appearing available area in the CF card returns to the state before 10-MB data is written.
- The available area in the memory does not change from the state when data is written.



- Writing a lot of data into the Write Filter area decreases the available memory. Therefore, during work, it's necessary to refrain from writing into the CF card as much as possible.

In order to solve this problem, RAM Disk is installed in XPE made by Pro-face.

In the RAM Disk, the area for the specified size can be used as a volatile disk area. Therefore, that area can be used again and again when writing directly into the memory area whether the Write Filter is effective or not. If the RAM Disk becomes a data storage place like Internet Explorer's Cache, it's possible to get the system to operate without changing the available memory volume for a long time. And logging data etc such as users' applications is one of the data that can use the RAM Disk effectively. For details and settings of the RAM Disk, refer to [5 RAM Disk].

## 5 Copying the CF card

When copying the same setting environment of the CF card to multiple panel computers, use the following procedure to copy the CF card.

- NOTE** • By not copying the CF card through the following procedure, a CF card with the same security ID will be created. A security ID is a unique ID assigned to each panel computer. Computers that have the same security ID will be recognized as the same computer on the Microsoft Network.

### 5.1 Copying the CF card procedure

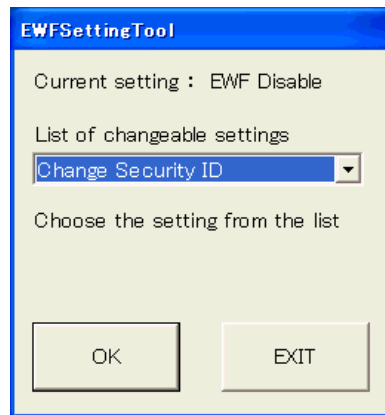
- (1) Disable the Write Filter.

When the Write Filter is enable, the security ID cannot be changed.

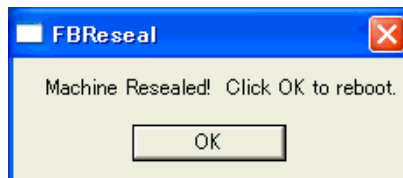
☞ "4.1 Write Filter Settings Procedure" (Page 1-7)

- (2) Start "EWFSettingTool.exe" and select "Change Security ID" and click [ok]. (Executable file is "C:\Proface\EWFSettingTool\EWFSettingTool.exe".)

- IMPORTANT** • Changing the setting requires the administrator's authority.



- (3) The following dialog box will appear.



- (4) Click [OK] and the unit is rebooted automatically.
- (5) BIOS is displayed. While BIOS is displayed, press [F2]key or [Delete]key.  
Turn off the power supply after BIOS setup screen is displayed and copy the CF card.
- (6) Reboot by using the CF card which you have copied. The security ID will be changed during the first reboot.

**IMPORTANT**

- It may take a long time to boot but since changing the security ID, do not turn off the power supply.

- (7) After the security ID is changed, the XPE is restarted automatically.

**NOTE**

- After restart, Write Filter becomes enable and it is not necessary to set it again.
- When you change the security ID, the MACHINE\_NAME would be changed and therefore the Event Error occurs.

There are no affects for this error.

## 6 RAM Disk

Use the RAM Disk to solve the memory leak caused by the Write filter.

RAM Disk will enable to write the data directly into the memory area.

Therefore, the area of the RAM Disk can be used again and again whether the Write filter is enabled or not.

Refer to the following below for the memory leak caused by the Write filter.

☞ "4.2 Access operation to the CF card of the Write filter" (Page 1-8)

If the RAM Disk is used as a data storage area such as for Internet Explorer's cache, it is possible to get the system to operate without changing the available memory volume for a long time.

Logging data such as users' applications is one of the data types that can use the RAM Disk effectively.

<In the factory settings>

Drive Letter: Z

Size: 4MB

### NOTE

- Do not change the Drive Letter setting.
- Even using the RAM Disk, the memory leak will not be solved completely.

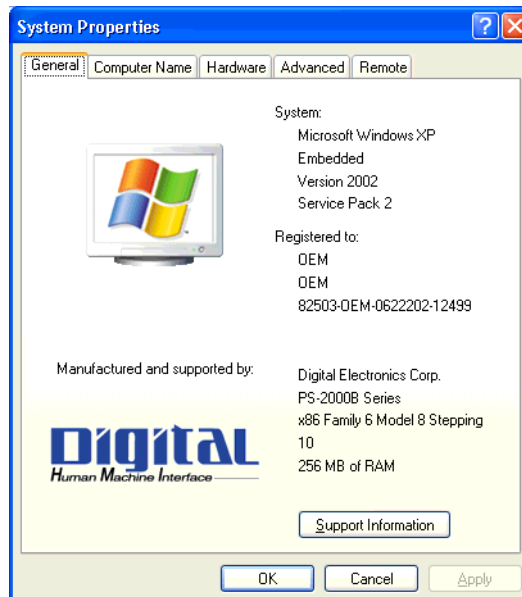

### NOTE

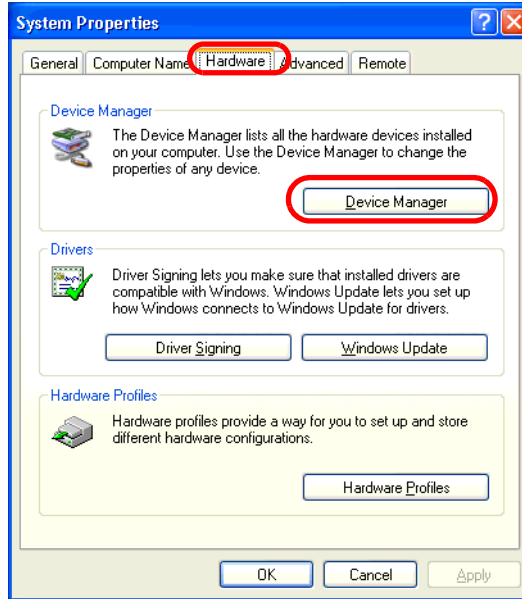
- Before setting the RAM Disk, disable the Write Filter setting. When the Write Filter is effective, the change is not reflected.

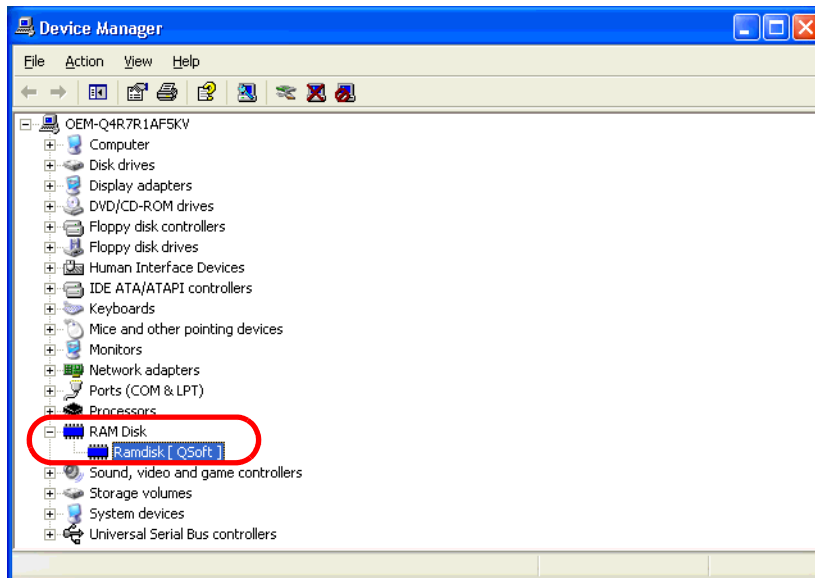
- (1) Start the system in the control panel.



- (2) Select the [Hardware] tab and then [Device Manager].



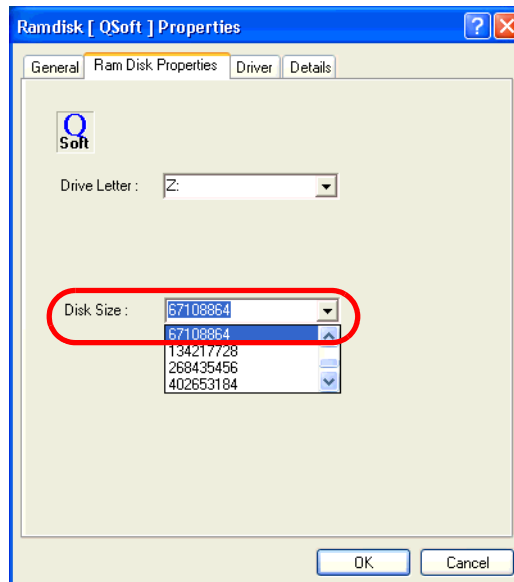
- (3) The following dialog box will appear. Click the “+” mark on the left from the [RAM Disk] and double-click [Ram disk[QSoft]].



- (4) The following dialog box will appear. Select the [Ram Disk Properties] tab.



- (5) Set a RAM Disk area in [Disk Size].



**IMPORTANT**

- The maximum value of the RAM Disk area is 67108864. When the value over the maximum value is set, an error occurs.

**NOTE**

- Do not change the Drive Letter setting.

- (6) Restart the unit.

## 7 Unit Settings

### 7.1 Backlight Brightness

This tool adjusts the Backlight settings. The backlight can be set to any of 4 levels of brightness.

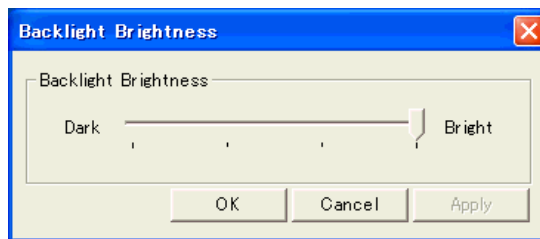
#### ■ Backlight Settings - Adjustment Procedure

**NOTE**

- Before setting the Backlight Brightness, disable the Write Filter setting. When the Write Filter is effective, the change is not reflected.

☞ "4.1 Write Filter Settings Procedure" (Page 1-7)

- (1) Double click the Control Panel's [Backlight Brightness] icon on the Control Panel.



- (2) Select the required level of brightness. (4 levels)
- (3) Click [OK] and end.

**NOTE**

- PS-2000B does not have this function.

## 7.2 KeyClick

This is a software keyboard (KeyClick32) of IN-fINITY soft make. Please surely read the License agreement on the appendix before using it.

☞ "1 [IN-fINITY soft KeyClick32] Agreement" (Page A-2)

When changing font size, set the setting referring the following diagram.

### NOTE

- Only Japanese and English are supported.  
When operating the key input from the touch panel in the language except the above mentioned, use Microsoft's Screen Keyboard.
- It cannot be used for password input when starting this unit.
- It cannot be used for command prompt.

### ■ KeyClick Settings Procedure

### NOTE

- Before setting the KeyClick, disable the Write Filter setting. When the Write Filter is effective, the change is not reflected.

☞ "4.1 Write Filter Settings Procedure" (Page 1-7)

- (1) Start as the next. [Start]-->[All program]-->[KeyClick]  
(Executable file is C:\Proface\KeyClick\KeyClick.exe)
- (2) When changing font size, set the setting referring the following diagram.

### IMPORTANT

- You have to log on as Power User in order to set the KeyClick.

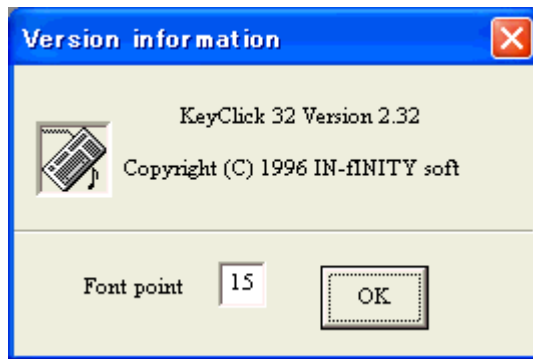
(1) Click here and display dialog for changing font size.

(2) Click PW and end KeyClick. Restart KeyClick and the contents of change becomes effective.

## 7.3 UPDD

UPDD is the touch panel driver for the mouse emulation (DMC Co. Ltd. make). Before using, be sure to read the license arrangement on the appendix.

☞ "2 [DMC Corporation Mouse Emulation Software] SLA" (Page A-3)

UPDD is not installed in PS-2000B before shipment. Please install it following the procedure below if needed.

### ■ UPDD Installation procedure

**NOTE**

- Before installing the UPDD, disable the Write Filter setting. When the Write Filter is effective, the installation is not reflected.

☞ "4.1 Write Filter Settings Procedure" (Page 1-7)

- (1) Start setup.exe from the folder UPDD in XPE's CD-ROM. Following the Installer's instructions, install the UPDD.

(Executable file is \UPDD\setup.exe in the CD-ROM of the XPE.)

### ■ Correction procedure for touch point

- (1) Start as the next. [Start]-->[All program]-->[UPDD] and [Calibration].

(Executable file is C:\Program Files\UPDD\TBCALIB.exe)

- (2) Touch the arrow on the screen. Pressing [OK] on the [Confirmation after calibration] dialog box completes the correction.

## 7.4 Delete Language

When using the Multilanguage version, deleting unnecessary languages can increase the available area of the CF card. The Japanese version doesn't have this function.

- IMPORTANT**
- The language that has been deleted once cannot be undone. It's recommended to back it up in advance using the Recovery Tool.

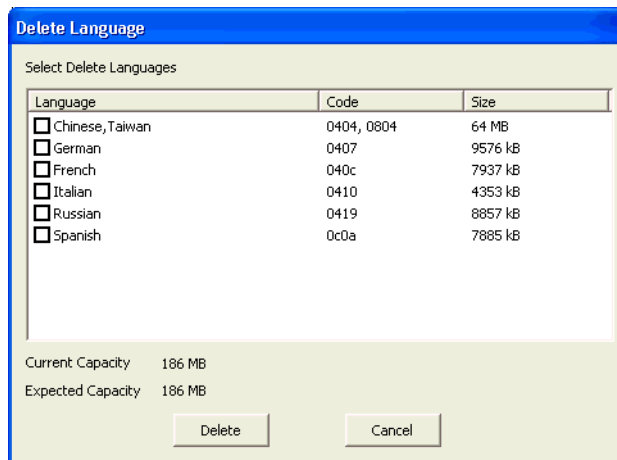
Deleting unnecessary languages procedure is as follows.

### ■ Delete Language Settings Procedure

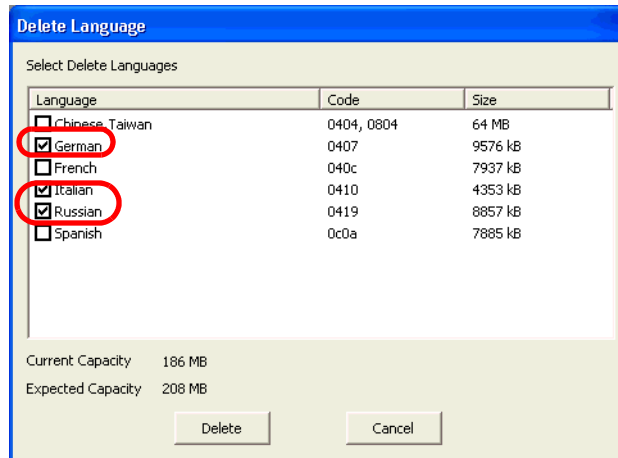
- NOTE**
- Before deleting the language, disable the Write Filter setting. When the Write Filter is effective, the change is not reflected.

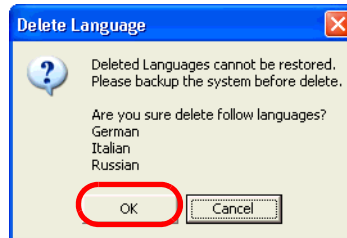
- (1) Open [Start]->[Run] and enter the path as follows: C:\Proface\DeleteLanguage\DelLang.exe. After starting it, the following dialog box will appear.



- (2) Check the language to delete. (Current Capacity shows the current available capacity. Expected Capacity shows the available area after delete.)



- (3) After checking the available capacity after delete, select the [Delete] button.
- (4) The following dialog box will appear. Click [OK].



- (5) Restart the unit.

## 7.5 Windows Media Player

It's necessary to download the Windows Media Player.

**NOTE**

- The following URL may be changed. For details, please check Sun Microsystems's site.
- Before installing Windows Media Player, disable the Write Filter setting. When the Write Filter is effective, the installation is not reflected.

## 7.6 Java Runtime

For Java Runtime, the required Java VM's version differs depending on a user application. Therefore Java Runtime is not installed before shipment. When using Java Runtime with Web terminal so on, be careful with the following things and install following the procedure.

## 8 Notes on turning off the power

In the factory settings, the Write Filter function is set as disable. When data is written in the devices (except CF card) that are not protected by the Write Filter, turning off the power may cause damage of the data.

### ■ When Write Filter is enabled

It is not necessary to perform the shutdown procedure. Confirm that no data is being written into another device, follow the steps of Safely Remove Hardware, and then turn off the power. However, the OS setting changed and the data written to the CF card during the time will be canceled and lost when the power is turned off.

<How to confirm that no data is being written into another device>

Hard Disk : Confirm that the LED of the IPC Series is turned off.

USB Device/PCMCIA : Confirm that no data is written on user's applications.

### ■ When Write Filter is disabled

It is necessary to perform the shutdown procedure. Because the write protection is not enabled, the OS setting changed and the data written to the CF card will be enabled.



## 9 Backup/Recovery of the CF Card

There's the Backup/Recovery Tool for recovery of XPE.

The Backup/Recovery Tool is open in the Pro-face web site only. (URL <http://www.pro-face.com/>)

For downloading the Backup/Recovery Tool and how to use it, refer to the web site shown above.

The Recovery Tool can be used only when the following conditions are satisfied.

- Only the CF Card made by Pro-face is used.
- Only the XPE CF card made by Pro-face is saved.

## 10 Restrictions

- Help document is not installed.
- Memory used when starting Window XP Embedded is approximately 160 MB in the Japanese version and approximately 130 MB in the Multilanguage version.
- When the memory has 128MB, the XPE cannot be used. Use it with the memory that has 256MB or more.
- The virtual memory function cannot be used. The OS may stop depending on the memory allocation of application software used.
- The function to save Cache in Internet Explorer and Internet Information Service is set as shown below before shipment.
  - Cache File: Minimum Value
  - Internet Information Service: disable
  - Since the cache files are saved on RAM DISK, those files are deleted when you turn off the XPE.

**NOTE**

- The function of Windows Update is the online support to update Windows automatically and make the system the newest condition. But XPE does not correspond to Microsoft's Windows Update Service. When executing Windows Update on the Internet, a certain update module will fail. Consequentially do not execute installation on the Internet.
- The large-size application software such as iFIX or SCADA software so on cannot be installed.
